

C.C.C. SENIOR GOLF LEAGUE RULES

Senior Golf Rules 2026

1. The Senior Golf League is for men whom are fifty (50) years or older and are members of the Clinton Country Club.
2. Play ready golf.
3. Play the ball up. The lie may be improved no more than six inches and no nearer to the hole. Scramble Play – the ball may be moved one club length, no nearer to the hole. The lie may be moved from rough to fairway, but not on the green.
4. On holes 6, 10 and 17 if the ball is on the water, you may move to the other side of the water and hit the next ball, nearest point of relief, with one stroke penalty.
5. All putts are to be putted out.
6. When scrambling, all players tee up utilizing those tees used to establish Senior League scoring average, (Club events may utilize a different method based on age)
7. If a ball is lost (out-of-bounds), the penalty is one stroke. The ball is to be played as if it was taking relief from a hazard.
8. The golfer's league handicap will be determined in a method approved by the CCC Golf Professional. Only rounds played in league play will be utilized in calculating league handicap.
9. Play will be per USGA rules excepted as noted in the local Senior League Rules

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
